La Arena Beach



Starting in Bilbao, take the A-8 motorway to the Muskiz-La Arena exit and head towards Pobeña. Here you'll have to choose between two options: strolling along the natural dunes of **La Arena Beach** or taking the **Itsaslur Rail Trail**.



Zierbena



Zierbena is a small fishing port town that maintains its traditional charm and wonderful fish and seafood grills. It is part of the Northern Way of St. James. There is a great zeal for rowing here. You can also discover the curious traditional Basque sport "bolos a katxete".



Santurtzi

Traditional fishing village where you can visit **Casa Torre Palace** (18th century) and its historical information centre. The Brotherhood of Fishermen building houses the **Santurtzi Itsas-
oa Museum**. In the summertime you can take a whale watching tour on the Bay of Biscay. Reservations required. A visit to one of the last traditional wooden fishing boats left on the Cantabrian Sea, the **Atunero Agurtza**, is another riveting option here.



Portugalete

Portugalete is a medieval town on the Bilbao Estuary. Its Old Quarter is well worth a visit, as well as its Gothic-Renaissance Basilica of **Santa María**. You can walk along the estuary to **Salazar Tower** and enjoy the charm of the **Plaza del Solar** with its neoclassical gazebo.



Bizkaia Bridge

i

Bizkaia Bridge, also known as the Hanging Bridge, has been a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** since 2006 and is the point of connection between the two banks of the estuary. It connects Portugalete and the Las Arenas district of Getxo: the industrial, working class left bank and the residential, bourgeoisie right bank. You can cross it with your car on board its gondola or take the vertiginous walkway above.

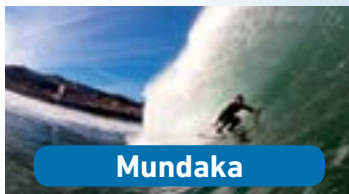
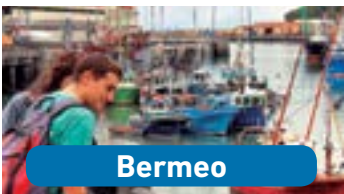
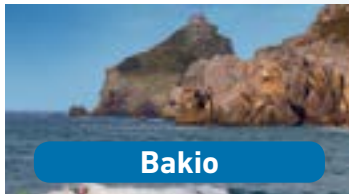
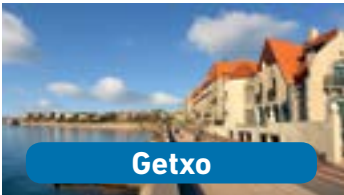


Getxo

i

Getxo is a large municipality including the settlements of **Las Arenas, Algorta, Romo, Neguri, and Andra Mari**. We recommend taking a walk along the seaside. You'll be awestruck by the grandeur of the gentry palaces. Their refined British style demonstrates the relationships established between the British islands and the great business families in the area at the time. Another great idea is taking a swim at the elegant **Ereaga beach** or taking a stroll along its marina.

Getxo



This municipality is comprised of the settlements of **Las Arenas, Algorta, Romo, Neguri, and Andra Mari**. We recommend taking a walk along the seaside. You'll be awestruck by the grandeur of the gentry palaces. Their refined British style demonstrates the relationships established between the British islands and the great business families in the area at the time. Take a swim at the elegant **Ereaga beach**, take a stroll along its marina, and certainly visit the **Old Port** of Algorta, a charming fishing neighbourhood that climbs up an escarpment.



Sopela



Before you arrive, in **Berango** you can visit the **Iron Belt History Museum** built during the Spanish Civil War to defend Bilbao. **Sopela** is the perfect place for **surfing**. Its beaches are flanked by breathtaking cliffs. **Barinatxe-La Salvaje** is a beach with its own dune system. Above **Arriaterra-Atxabiribil** beach, you'll find a number of lively bars with great views of the sunset.



Plentzia and Gorliz

i

Plentzia is a triple threat: it's got an estuary, a beach with calm waters, and a marina. The bay, which it shares with **Gorliz**, offers a unique experience: wine tastings and underwater immersion at the world's first underwater winery and artificial reef. At the bottom of the bay you'll find the **petrified dunes** of Gorliz, from which you can walk to the **Gorliz Lighthouse**.



Bakio

i

Bakio features Bizkaia's longest beach, which is great for **surfing**. This is a town that has known how to maintain a significant rural economy centred around caserío farmhouses. One result of this is the production and sale of **txakoli**, a young, refreshing, and quintessentially Basque wine, the history of which you can discover at the **Txakolingunea** Txakoli Winemaking Museum.



San Juan de Gaztelugatxe

i

Heading toward **Bermeo**, you'll find the islet of **San Juan de Gaztelugatxe**, one of the most spectacular spots on the Basque coast and a famous "Game of Thrones" filming location. After you go over a two-arch bridge, gather the strength you need to climb the 241 stairs to the small hermitage of San Juan. When you get to the top, don't forget to ring the bell three times, make a wish, and therefore drive away evil spirits.



Bermeo

i

A visit to **Bermeo** means immersing yourself in the culinary pleasure of marmitako tuna and potato stew and canned albacore, tuna, and anchovies. This incredibly charming fishing village has a long history of whaling, which you can learn about at the **Fishing Museum**. Going out for pintxos, visiting the old port, and enjoying the views of the cliffs and **Izaro island** from la Tala park are all part of a great itinerary here.



Mundaka

i

This **international surfing destination** has the longest left-breaking wave in Europe. Mundaka is set around the **fishing port**, the most picturesque spot in town and a place for gathering and enjoying the company of friends. Thanks to its strategic location, the **hermitage of Santa Catalina** oversees the comings and goings on the estuary and offers one of the best panoramic views you'll find on the coast of Bizkaia.



Gernika

i

This small town is an icon recognized around the world thanks to Picasso's painting depicting the cruelty and senselessness of the Spanish civil war. The town is now a symbol of peace. It contains the **Assembly House** and its famous tree, a tribute to the rights and freedoms of the Basque people. The **People of Europe Park**, the **Peace Foundation Museum**, the **Basque Country Museum**, and **Santa María Church** are all worth visiting.

It is also home to famous peppers and beans. This town holds a market every Monday year-round and the large "**Last Monday in Gernika**" agricultural fair on the last Monday in October.

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Santimamiñe

i

The **Santimamiñe Cave**, near **Kortezubi**, is a **UNESCO World Heritage Site**. It has nearly 50 beautiful cave paintings and an information centre equipped with the latest exhibition technology.



Urdaibai



The **Urdaibai estuary** is a natural area formed at the mouth of the Oka river. Its great ecological value led it to be classified a **Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO** and part of the **Natura Network**. It is an important place where migratory birds rest. You can observe these birds from the **Urdaibai Bird Centre**.

Laga and Laida



The beaches of **Laida and Laga** are very close to one another and are golden sand paradises surrounded by high mountains. These unique beaches are surrounded by nature. Unbeatable for swimming, these beaches are also great for surfing, kayaking, stand-up paddle boarding, and canoeing on the Urdaibai Estuary



Elantxobe

i

A breathtaking town set between two cliffs. Have a rest by the **tide pools at the port**. It is a truly exciting starting point for a number of hikes such as the route to the **cape and Ogoño viewpoint**.



Lekeitio and Ea

i

Before you reach Lekeitio you'll find the magical village of **Ea**. It's a tiny fishing village with a small cove at the end of the estuary.

Lekeitio boasts a colourful port, a wide array of bars and restaurants, a legendary island, incredible, long beaches, and a majestic old quarter. The Gothic **altarpiece at Santa María de la Asunción church** is also noteworthy.



Ondarroa

i

Its old quarter notably contains **Likona Tower**, the **church of Andra Mari** (both from the 15th century) and the old **Brotherhood of Fishing building**. As a very important fishing port, this is the perfect place to eat **fish and seafood**: marmitako tuna and potato stew, baby squid, roasted sea bream, hake á la ondarresa, clams in green sauce, etc. It all pairs well with a **txakoli** from Bizkaia.



Markina-Xemein

i

This town is on the Northern Way of St. James. Its Renaissance and Baroque palaces and monasteries demonstrate its glittering past. The hexagonally-shaped hermitage of **San Miguel de Arretxinaga** curiously has a six-sided pyramidal roof. The **church of Xemein** is probably the largest in Bizkaia.

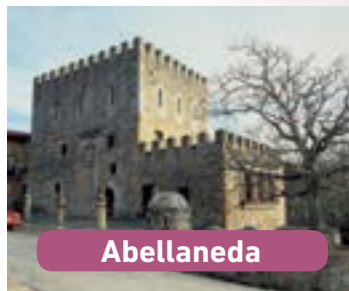


Zenarruza

i

On the way to **Bolivar**, you'll find the **Collegiate Church of Ziortza** also known as the **Zenarruza Monastery**. It's an important historic and artistic monument on the **Primitive Northern Way of St. James** with a notable plateresque cloister, the only one in Bizkaia. It is a Cultural Heritage Site of the Basque Country. It has an inn that is open year-round, except on Christmas Day.

Güeñes

i

When you arrive in **Güeñes**, you'll find **Villa Urrutia**, a home that now functions as the town hall, a silent witness to residents returning wealthy from the Americas. Noteworthy religious architecture includes the **church of Santa de María** (16th century) a striking example of Isabelline and Renaissance architecture.

ARENATZarte, in Arenatza park (Güeñes) is a **botanic garden** that combines nature and art and is home to unique trees and avant-garde sculptures. If you're visiting with your family, be sure to stop at **Bizkaia Park Abentura** (temporarily closed), with its obstacle courses, bouncy castles, and rock climbing wall.



Zalla

i

This town with a history tied to border disputes and old forges has preserved its invaluable historical legacy with sites such as the 17th century **Murga Palace**, now the Town Hall, and the **Terreros Tower**. The **San Pedro de Zarikete hermitage** is notable and has a sprout from the Tree of Gernika planted next to it.



Abellaneda

i

The **Abellaneda Assembly House**, which belongs to **Sopuerta**, was where the councils of the region would make decisions on shared issues from the 14th to the 19th century. Today, it is a symbol of the privileges and freedoms afforded to these towns as they were annexed by the Lordship of Bizkaia. It is also home to the **Encartaciones Museum**.

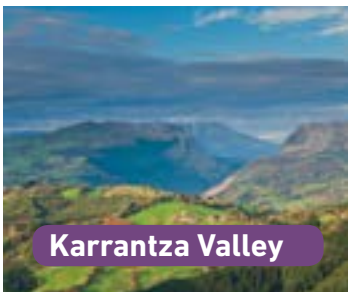


Balmaseda

i

This town has an incredibly beautiful **old quarter** presided over by the **Viejo Bridge**, the oldest testament to the town's wall. **Balmaseda's Easter celebration** is known for putting on a realistic Passion Play that attracts more than 50,000 people. The **Boinas La Encartada Museum**, a defunct factory that manufactured traditional "txapela" berets, will take you back to the end of the industrial revolution. You'll certainly want to see "**las Putxeras**", pots that the train operators of the Bilbao-La Robla line used to cook a traditional bean stew with the heat of the coal from their boilers. A number of toppings are offered with the dish (pork ribs, salt pork, chorizo, blood sausage, etc.).

El Pobal

i

El Pobal Forge is a hydraulic forge typical of the 13th-14th centuries. It was restored in the 18th century, when it took on its current look. You can tour the forge compound itself to see the manor where the forgers lived, a small bread oven, and a flour mill.



Loizaga Tower

i

The medieval **Loizaga Tower** houses a world-renowned **Antique and Classic Car Museum**. It has a special private collection of mint condition **Rolls-Royces**. Not far is **Sopuerta Abentura**, a forest adventure park for the entire family. There you'll find 10 courses – three of them including zip lines – with different activities done atop the trees ranging from 1 to 21 metres high and different levels of difficulty.



Karrantza Valley

i

Karrantza is a place with a smattering of small settlements with a long history. This history goes from the Palaeolithic to the present. Standing here now are traditional caserío farmhouses with an industrial past. **Armañón Natural Park**, the dolmen route, the old dolomite plant, caves including Pozalagua, and mansions built by emigrants returning from the Americas demonstrate the variety of places of interest offered by this remarkable valley.



Karpin Abentura

i

This is a **wild animal shelter** whose tour will also take you back to the Jurassic, following the footsteps of dinosaurs. It is a family-oriented responsible tourism establishment where you can learn how to act in nature and make a commitment to sustainability.



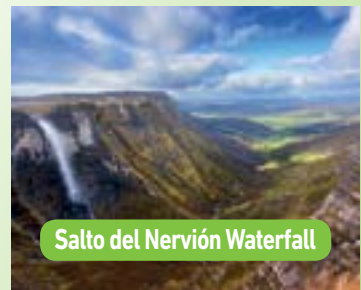
Pozalagua

i

The Pozalagua Caves were recognized as the **Best Corner of Spain** in 2013, as they contain the largest concentration of eccentric stalactites in the world. The walk through the grotto takes a metal walkway that leads to “Versailles Hall”, after walking through a lake that was dried up by mining activity. At the back is an arch-shaped viewpoint shaped that allows you to contemplate the cave’s beauty in all its splendour.

Gordexola

i

In **Gordexola**, the iron industry was quite important. Its forges were active **until the mid 20th century**. It is also a place with palaces, villas, and manors, as well as tower houses and luxurious mansions built by people who went to the Americas to make their fortunes.



Artziniega

i

In the neighbouring province of **Araba**, in the Aiara valley, you can discover the town of Artziniega, a small medieval settlement that notably includes **Artziniega Tower**, the **Ethnography Museum**, and the **Sanctuary of Nuestra Señora de la Encina**.



Quejana



Also in Araba, you'll find **Quejana**, whose centre is a monumental ensemble comprising a fortified palace, a church, a Dominican Convent, and the Virgen del Cabello Chapel Tower.



Orduña



Orduña is the only settlement in Bizkaia with the title of **city**. Once an important commercial and customs hub on the border with Castille, it has a rich civil and religious heritage. **Plaza de los Fueros** is a great starting point for walking and cycling routes through the **Sierra Salvada mountains**.

Orozko



Wander the streets of **Orozko** and discover the **church of San Bartolomé de Olarte**, the **Anunzibai bridge**, and the **Legorburu Mansion**, home to the **Ethnography Museum**.

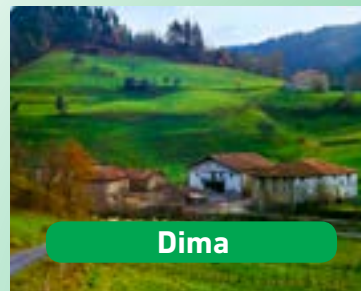
Salto del Nervión Waterfall



The horsetail waterfall is almost 300 metres tall. You'll need to climb the **Orduña pass** and, once you're at the top, you can park and walk along the forest trail, following the **Fuente Santiago-Salto del Nervión** route. Important: the best time to see the waterfall is during the rainy season or while the ice in the mountains is melting.

Arratia Valley

from Igorre to Dima





Igorre



This tranquil village knows how to enjoy the little things. It notably contains the 17th century **Vildósola Palace**, **Zubizarreta House**, and the different **baserris** (caserío farmhouses) built during the period between the 16th and 18th centuries.

Areatza



This town is under the shelter of **Gorbeia**, Bizkaia's tallest mountain and the namesake of the Natural Park. **Areatza** has a wealth of architectural sites to visit: Santa Isabel convent, the church of San Bartolomé, as well as Gortazar palace and the Neoclassical town hall in the town square. Here you'll also find the **Information Centre or Parketxe** where the whole family can learn more about this space.



Gorbeia



Gorbeia Natural Park is the largest nature reserve in the Basque Country. The park is home to a mountain of the same name, **Gorbeia**, which, at 1,842 m, is the tallest in Bizkaia. At the top, you'll find an 18-metre-tall cross, the symbol of the park.



Otzarreta



The spectacular **Otzarreta Beechwood** is a magical, enchanting place with a landscape straight out of a fairy tale. Its 100-year-old beech trees grow vertically instead of horizontally, because more than 50 years ago, their branches were pruned to get coal from their wood.



Otxandio



On the route from the Town Hall to the **Church of Santa Mariñe**, you'll find the notable **fountain in homage to the town's forges of old**. This beautiful town has a wealth of monuments to see.



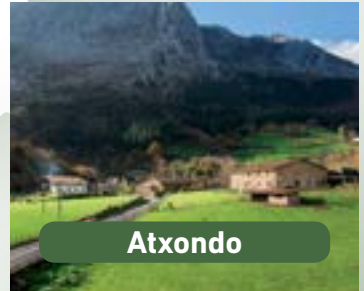
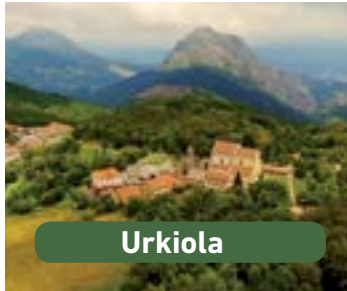
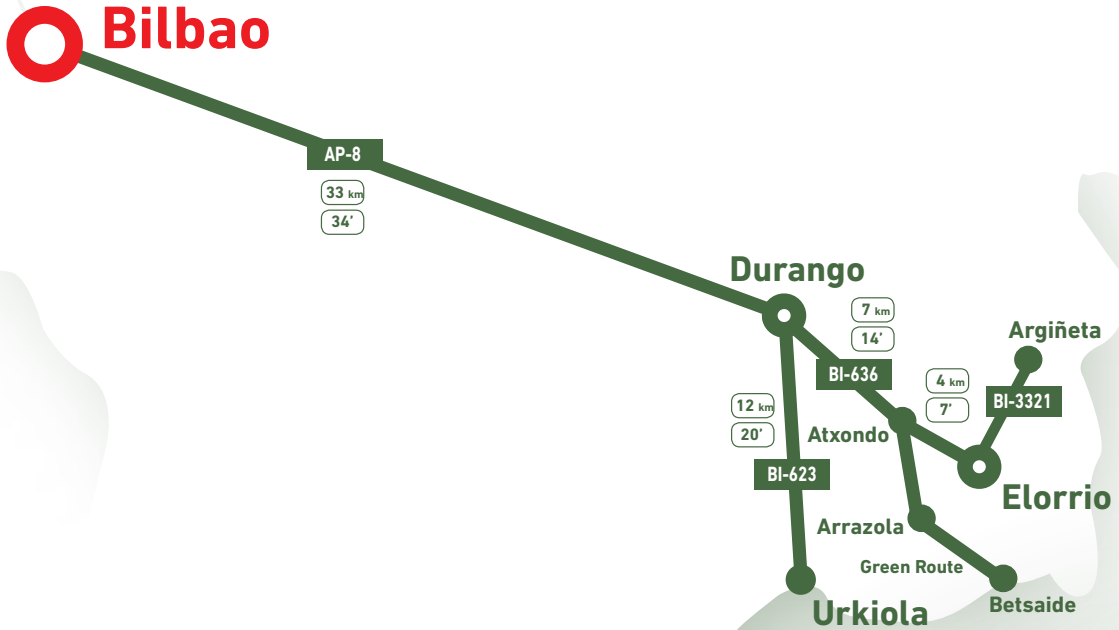
Dima



Dima's historic **sites include**: the San Pedro Apóstol church, the Humilladero hermitage, Urizar palace, Ziarrusta tower, and the Gothic church of Magdalena de Lamindao.

Durangaldea

from Bilbao to Duranguesado





Durango

i

Durango is a town in an incredibly beautiful natural setting full of opportunities for anyone who loves the outdoors. At the centre of town, you can discover emblematic buildings and sites such as the **Cross of Kurutziaga**, the **Basilica of Santa María de Uribarri**, a number of noble palaces, and the “**Memory Space**”, a monument erected in memory of the 1937 bombing of the town. Its **Basque Book and Music Fair**, which is held in December, is the Basque Country’s most important cultural fair.



Urkiola

i

At **Urkiola Natural Park** you can also hike, rock climb, rappel, or trek. On its slopes, you’ll find the **Sanctuary of Santos Antonios** (Abad and Padua). In front of it, there is a stone that, according to popular belief, is a meteorite with special powers; if walk around it three times, you’ll soon find a partner. The area has a number of inns, hostels, and restaurants.



Atxondo

i

If you're in the mood for a tranquil family stroll, **in Atxondo**, the **Arrazola Green Route** offers a totally flat 10 km trek, about two hours round trip. This will allow you to enjoy the greenest, most rural side of Bizkaia.



Betsaide

i

If you love mountains, we recommend climbing **Betsaide**. After an hour of easy ascent on a well-marked path, you'll reach the peak, where you'll find unparalleled views and can relax in the mountain silence. It's the exact point where the three territories of the Basque Country (Araba, Gipuzkoa, and Bizkaia) meet.



Elorrio



The town's invaluable historic sites are simply remarkable: palaces and stone manors with exquisite masonry, the **Santa Ana Monastery**, the **Basilica of Purísima Concepción**, the **Don Tello gate**, the **Tola Palace**, and the ruins of the **Medieval Wall**.



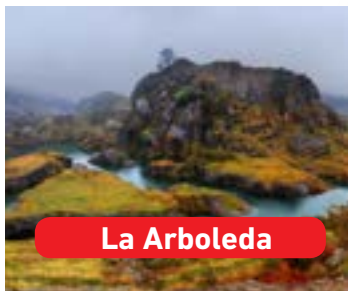
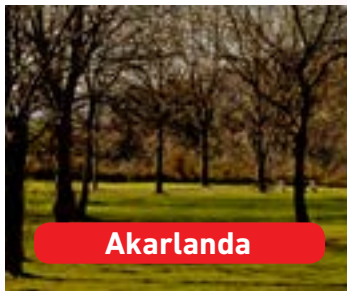
Argiñeta



On the outskirts of Elorrio, you'll find the fascinating **Argiñeta cemetery**, one of the most important funerary monuments in the Basque Country, built in the High Middle Ages.

Artxanda



We recommend taking in the one-of-a-kind view of the **Botxo** (Basque for hole, how locals lovingly refer to their city) from **Artxanda Viewpoint**. The most exciting way up is on the **Artxanda Funicular**, which has been connecting Bilbao to the top of the mountain since 1915. It only takes three minutes to get to the top and you can hop on at Plaza del Funicular (calle Castaños).



Akarlanda



This is a park that is perfectly set in nature. It has parking, a futsal court, a basketball court, a skate park, and more. Bring a picnic to one of its outdoor tables near **Martiartu Tower**.



La Arboleda

i

The climb to the former mining area **La Arboleda** from Trapagaran can be done on the **Reineta Funicular**, which offers spectacular views of the Inlet of Bilbao. La Arboleda is a historic mining town that begins in the Triano mountains and is near the **Peñas Negras Environmental Information Centre**. You can find a number of lakes in the area. They were once pits used for open-pit iron mining.



Kobetamendi

i

Kobetamendi is one of Bilbao's key green spaces and a fine place to have fun with the family. It has a park next to a lake and offers spectacular views of the metropolitan area. In the summer, the park hosts the pop-rock music festival **Bilbao BBK LIVE**, which was attended by more than 140,000 people last year.
